Spirit of Ecstasy - Sculpture







DESCRIPTION

The Spirit of Ecstasy is known worldwide as Rolls-Royce's elegant bonnet sculpture. Originally designed in 1911 by British sculptor Charles Robinson Sykes, this refined statue depicts a woman gracefully leaning forward, her robes billowing in the wind.

More than just an ornament, the Spirit of Ecstasy symbolizes luxury, class, and the pursuit of perfection—values that Rolls-Royce embodies to this day.

This version is by Seán Mc Cann, a contemporary artist, designer, and sculptor from Bruges with Irish roots. He graduated as an interior designer from Sint-Lucas Ghent in 2008. Fueled by his interest in gravestones and passion for art, he has focused on the art of traditional stonework and sculpture.

The sculpture "Spirit of Ecstasy" was created for the Rolls-Royce stand at the Brussels Motor Show 2019.
